I will be learning to...

- Create winter music
- Move our bodies in response to classical music
- Take part in role play and drama activities

Mathematic

I will be learning to...

- Count, recognise and order number up to 10
- Match number to quantity correctly
- Count irregular arrangements of objects
- Continue simple repeating patterns
- Show an interest in number problems
- Compare sets
- Order items by weight/length and capacity

Literacy

I will be learning to...

- Hear and say initial sounds in words
- Orally segment spoken words and blend together
- Write simple CVC words
- Enjoy a range of books
- Find information using the computer

- Talk about things we have observed in the natural environment
- Understand decay and changes over time
- Look for similarities
- Develop skills in making technological toys work
