I will be learning to...

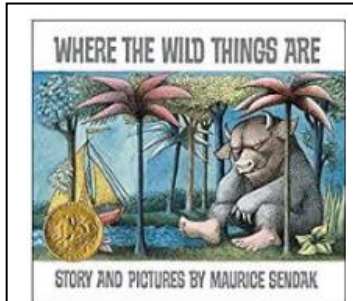
- Negotiate and solve problems
