I will be learning to...

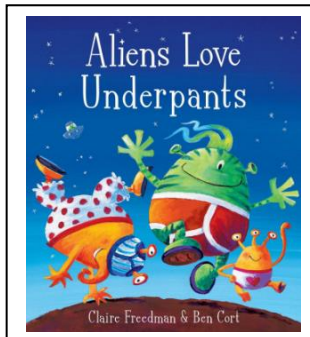
- talk about ways to keep myself healthy and safe
