

PE and Sport Premium Funding

In 2015/16 the school received £8,800 in two instalments. The money has been used to further develop staff expertise and knowledge, replenish playtime equipment, provide high quality PE and after school provision alongside the development of staff knowledge and to ensure the delivery of high quality PE lessons across school.
